## Regulatory highlights





#### **Kigali Amendment ratified**

The government of Lebanon approved joining the Kigali Amendment on 29 March 2019 under law 119/2019 and ratified the Kigali Amendment on 5 February 2020.

# National cooling plan implemented

Lebanon developed a national cooling plan that was published in May 2021 under the title of "Guidance for integrating efficient cooling in national policies in Lebanon."





### **Energy Conservation Law in place**

On 5 May 2022, the Council of Ministers approved the Energy Conservation Law and transferred it to the parliament for discussion and adoption.


### Regulatory recommendations

#### National certification scheme for RAC technicians

Cool Up will support training programmes to meet minimum requirements to address F-gas emission reductions, leakage control, documentation, and safe handling of alternative refrigerants.
